
Dressing up day ideas

- A shirt with a collar

- A small suitcase or satchel
- A cardboard box on a string for your gas mask
- A label with your name and address on





- A knee length dress or top and skirt. Floral prints and patterns were popular.
- A knitted cardigan or jumper
- School socks in a plain colour
- School shoes
- A long plain overcoat
- A beret or wooly hat
